DAY 1: MANILA - TAOYUAN - TAICHUNG (--/--/D)

Check in at NAIA, 3 hours prior the departure. Meet and greet the local tour guide and transfer to Leofoo Village - a safari and a theme park that features 3 kinds of roller coasters. After you enjoy the rides from the theme park, proceed for free shopping time at Feng Jia Night Market that was claimed to be the largest night market in Taiwan. Transfer to hotel for check in.

DAY 2: TAICHUNG - SUN MOON LAKE - KAOHSIUNG (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Sun Moon Lake (3H) with private boat tour – the largest body of water in Taiwan, famous for its clear, sparkling blue water with a scenic mountain backdrop. The lake that was surrounded by lush countryside has been designated as one of the Thirteen National Scenic Areas in Taiwan. Visit Wen Wu Temple, Ita Thao Indigeous Village, Holy Monk Shrine, Transfer to Kaohsiung then visit the Love River. Have free time at Leo Ho Night Market. Transfer to Kaohsiung for overnight stay.

DAY 3: KAOHSIUNG - KENTING - CHIHPEN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer to the oldest and southernmost park, the Kenting National Park (2H) - it is famous for its yellow sands, turquoise water and lush vegetation along with low mountains. The park is also a sanctuary of different wildlife from deer to migratory raptors (stop visit: Kenting Olanpi Light House, Maopitou, Kenting Street). Transfer to Chihpen for overnight stay, popular for its hot-spring area. (Bring swimsuit)

DAY 4: CHIHPEN - TAITUNG - HUALIEN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer to Hualien via ocean view coast way (3.5H). Enjoy tour to East Coast National Scenic Area, known as "Taiwan's last unspoiled land", stretches 170 kilometers down the east coast of the island. Tour stops will be Sanshseitai, Caves of the Eight Immortals, Stone Umbrella, Cisingtan Beach. Late afternoon, we will proceed to Hualien for overnight stay.

DAY 5: HUALIEN - TAROKO - TAIPEI (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to your full day Taroko National Park Full Day Tour (3H). It is one of the Nine National Parks in Taiwan and was named after the main landmark the Taroko Gorge, a long canyon that is composed of different kinds of rocks including marble which leads to its nickname "The Marble Gorge". Tour stops will includes Taroko Gorge, Swallow Grotto, Eternal and Spring Shrine, Tienshange. Transfer to Taipei (3H) then check in hotel.

DAY 6: TAIPEI (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Taipei whole day city sights. Visit the National Palace Museum that houses the largest collection of priceless Chinese artifacts and artworks. Proceed to Martyr's Shrine dedicated to the 390,000 soldiers that was killed during their resistance against the Japan and the Chinese Civil War. Visit Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall - it is the most prominent historical monument, landmark and tourist attraction in Taiwan. Free shopping time at Ximending Shopping Area and Taipei 101 (lift and observatory not included) - that was held as the "world's tallest building" from 2004 until 2010. Back to hotel.

DAY 7: TAIPEI (B/L/D)

After breakfast, visit the Yehliu Geographic Park - a cape that is composed of distinctive rock landscape that runs along the sea-eroded land that juts towards the ocean. In the afternoon, visit Chiufen Village - where you can still have a glimpse of previous lifestyle and unforgettable sceneries of the town. Back to hotel.

DAY 8: TAIPEI - TAOYUAN - MANILA (B/--/--)

After your breakfast, free time at your own leisure until the airport transfer to depart from Taiwan going back to Manila. **STANDARD CHECK-OUT TIME 1200H**
