DAY 1: MANILA - DEPARTURE (--/--)

Check in at NAIA, 3 hours before departure time.

DAY 2: ARRIVAL - INCHEON - SEOUL (B/L/D)

Upon arrival at Incheon International airport, meet the tour guide. After breakfast, transfer to Seoul. Visit the Gyeongbok Palace and National Folk Museum, where you can discover the historical facts that were used in the daily lives of ordinary Koreans. Pass by the Presidential Blue House, the official residence of the President of the Republic of Korea. Proceed to Bukchon Hanok Village and experience wearing Hanbok while visiting the area. Visit Tongin Market – where various traditional foods and items are being served by the locals. Proceed to N Seoul Tower for photo stop. Have dinner then check in at the hotel.

DAY 3: SEOUL (B/L/D)

After breakfast inside the hotel, visit Ginseng Shop. Transfer to Haneul Park – a grassland park located at World Cup Stadium Park. Visit Cosmetic shop and Red Pine. Free shopping time at Myeongdong Street. Have cruise at Han River and enjoy watching Banpo Bridge Fountain Show. Have dinner then check in at the hotel.

DAY 4: SEOUL - MUNGYEONG (B/L/D)

After breakfast inside the hotel, transfer to Mungyeong City (3H). Proceed to Mungyeong Saejae Provincial Park – the historical shooting place area of KBS Drama. Then visit Ominara and have tour at the winery. Have dinner then check in at the hotel.

DAY 5: MUNGYEONG - ANDONG - GYEONGJU (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Yecheon (40Mins). Proceed to Jinho Archery Field and experience Archery (10 arrows/person). Transfer to Andong and visit Hahoe Folk Village where you can see traditional houses and was visited by Queen Elizabeth of England in year 1999. Transfer to Gyeongju City and have tour at Seokbinggo (Stone Ice Storage), an ancient refrigerator only in Korea. Visit Cheomseongdae Observatory – an astronomical and is the oldest observatory in the world. Proceed to Anapji Pond. Then enjoy watching “Silla Basilla” performance – a story about love and the “Heroes of Silk road”. Have dinner then check in at the hotel.

DAY 6: GYEONGJU - BUSAN DEPARTURE (B/--/--)

After breakfast inside the hotel, have tour at Bulguksa Temple – is the representative relic of Gyeongju and was designated as a World Cultural Asset by UNESCO in 1995. The beauty of the temple itself and
